

UK Nacra 15 Sailing Chandlery GP Series 2026

Notice of Series

1 RULES

- 1.1** The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *International Nacra 15 Class Rules*.
- 1.2** The rules governing each event in the series will be specified in the *Notice of Race if published and Sailing Instructions* published for each event (taking precedence over this *Notice of Series* if there is any conflict).
- 1.3** Competitors should note that the UK Nacra 15 Class Association implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the charter, which can be found at www.rya.org.uk/racing/rules/racing-charter

2 SERIES EVENTS

- 2.1** The series will consist of the following events:

1	UK Nacra 15 GP 1	7/8 March 2026	Spring Championships Warsash SC
2	UK Nacra 15 GP 2	16/17 May 2026	Rutland SC Cat Open
3	UK Nacra 15 GP 3	20/21 June 2026	East Coast Piers Race
4	UK Nacra 15 GP 4	12/13 September 2026	Weston SC Cat Open
5	UK Nacra 15 GP 5	17/18 October 2026	Inland Championships. Grafham Water Cat Open

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The series is open to members of the UK Nacra 15 Class Association sailing a Nacra 15 class catamaran. Membership to the UK Nacra 15 Class Association is available at www.nacra15uk.ourclubadmin.com
- 3.2** Every such team (Helm and crew) that enters and registers in the Nacra 15 class at one of the series events will automatically be entered into the series.
- 3.3** Each “boat team” can count a result with an alternative sailor aboard for 1 event in the series
- 3.4** Event entry to each of the series events will be published by each of the associated event organisers, with the UK Nacra 15 Class Association endeavouring to share all relevant event information via social media channels.

4 SCORING

- 4.1** For the purpose of scoring the series, a team’s score for each event will be the points equal to her position in the overall results for the Nacra 15 class at the event.
- 4.2** When a team does not enter an event, their event score for that event will be one more than the largest registered entry of Nacra 15s at any of the series events.
- 4.3** Each team’s series score will be their 3 best scores from all events.
- 4.4** The team with the lowest series score wins and others will be ranked accordingly
- 4.5** RRS A8 will be used to break series ties, replacing “race” with “event”

5 SERIES PRIZES

- 5.1** The UK Nacra 15 Class Association will endeavour to award series prizes
